Synopsis

Promsical is a high-energy jukebox musical set in a secondary school where social cliques rule the hallways and everyone is obsessed with the upcoming Prom. Cheerleaders, jocks, geeks, goths, theatre kids, and even the youngest “Ducklings” all have strong opinions about who belongs and who doesn’t.

As excitement for Prom builds, tensions between the different groups boil over into arguments, insults, and eventually a huge food fight in the dining hall. Furious at the students’ inability to respect one another, the Head Teacher cancels Prom entirely, declaring it will only return if the students can prove they can get along.

Forced to work together, the students slowly begin breaking down stereotypes and discovering hidden sides to each other. The sporty jocks reveal artistic passions, the geeks admit they love dancing, and the goths and cheerleaders realise they may not be so different after all. Along the way, friendships form between unlikely people and romance blossoms between Carrie and Becca, whose relationship challenges Carrie’s mother’s expectations of what a “normal” Prom should look like.

Meanwhile, the younger Ducklings become the unexpected moral heart of the story, encouraging the older students to stop judging one another and embrace acceptance.

By Prom night, the school has transformed. Old rivalries are replaced with understanding, individuality is celebrated, and the students come together to create a Prom where everyone belongs. Promsical delivers a joyful message about inclusion, identity, friendship, and the importance of letting people be exactly who they are.

SCRIPT SAMPLE

Scene 1 – The Hall (ALL)

(SFX school bell. ALL enter, looking around and judging each other)

[Suggested song] BOOMERANG - Jojo Siwa (ALL)

****The song you choose needs to give a ‘surviving high school’ vibe****

HEAD TEACHER – Good morning, everyone. As you are all aware the end of term is creeping up on us which means...

ALL – PROM!!!

HEAD TEACHER – Yes, thank you... Prom. So, start doing... whatever it is you young people start doing to get yourselves ready for the best night of your life! This is Mrs Robins. As some of you may know she is Carries mum...

MRS R – *(Waving embarrassingly to CARRIE)* Hey baby.

HEAD TEACHER – And she will be in charge of sorting out... well everything. Can we all give Mrs Robins a round of applause!

(ALL clap and cheer and then go back to talking in their little groups. Each group comes to life as they speak and then freezes when another group speaks)

(Cheerleaders)

CINDY – So, are you going to ask him?

RILEY – Er... I don't think so. It's totally down to the boy to ask the



girl. Everyone knows that!

TRIXIE – Yeah come on Cindy! Get with the programme!

CARRIE – Cindy’s right. I thought in this day and age... you know, it doesn’t matter.

RILEY – Carrie, don’t be so ridiculous! Do you wanna go and stand over there with the weirdos... *(She points at BECCA)*

(Geeks)

BECCA – So... Prom time!

POLLY – Oh great. The night I’ve been waiting for... NOT!

CAT – Public humiliation in its highest form!

MILLY – We don’t have to go do we?

CAT – I hope not!

BECCA – Come on guys. It’s not that bad.

POLLY – I don’t know why we still have Prom?

MILLY – Because humans like that *(Pointing to the JOCKS)* would die otherwise!!!

(Jocks)

BRANDON – When are you going to ask her dude?

ZACK – Soon Bro. Soon. Got to wait for the right time!

DENNY – Do you think she’s going to say yes?



ZACK – Of course she’s going to say yes! I mean... Look at me! Why wouldn’t she!

BRANDON – *(To DENNY)* What about you dude?

DENNY – I’m not really into anyone right now so...

WES – That doesn’t matter. Just pick someone... Hey... How about her... *(He points at SARAH)*

(Gleeks)

SARAH – I need to be in charge of the music! I would totally kill it!

PAUL – You SO would!

DIXIE – And I need to be in charge of decorations. I would totally kill it!

PAUL – You SO would!

SARAH – And you can be in charge of...

PAUL – Being fabulous!

(Goths)

BOSCO – *(Seeing PAUL and being appalled)* Being fabulous... Ergh.

LAUREN – Oh God make it stop. *(To BOSCO)* Are you going to go?

BOSCO – I couldn’t think of anything worse!

FREDDY – Yeah. Spending an evening of my life I’ll never get back with those people!! Score!!!



LAUREN – I think we should go. We’d ruin their night just by being there!!

BOSCO – All that colour... makes me sick!

FREDDY – Tell me about it!

(Ducklings)

A DUCKLING (D) – Miss Kirby, do we get to go to Prom?

MISS K – Unfortunately not I’m afraid.

D – But, why?

MISS K – Because it’s just for the older kids.

D – But I AM older. Well, older than I was yesterday!

D – Which means by Prom she’ll be older again!!

MISS K – True and very clever but it’s still no I’m afraid.

D – That’s not fair!

MISS K – Just think, it’s something to look forward to when you’re older.

D – I think we should make a stand!

D – That’s a great idea!
