Synopsis

Once a thriving family holiday resort, Sunshine Sands is now a fading seaside hotel struggling to survive. Years ago, the resort was bursting with life, music, games and unforgettable memories, run by passionate owners Peyton, Parker, Frankie and Blake alongside their energetic team. But changing times, budget holidays, and fierce competition have left the once-thriving destination nearly deserted.

As the staff battle low morale, cutbacks and increasingly unhappy guests, disaster strikes when three stern inspectors from trip-assistor.com arrive to review the hotel. If Sunshine Sands fails their inspection, the resort will be shut down for good.

At the same time, a group of lifelong friends Bo, Charlie, Robin, Leigh, Jo, Sam, Jax and Ezra return to Sunshine Sands hoping to relive the summers of their childhood. SCRIPT SAMPLE

Scene 3 – A House

(A group of friends are listening to music and looking through old photos while packing for a holiday)

BO – Oh my, look at this one!

CHARLIE – Awww look how little we are.

ROBIN – Look how happy we look.

LEIGH – Look how YOUNG we look!

JO – I'm so glad we are going back to Sunshine Sands you guys.

SAM – Yeah me too. I've got such good memories of this place as a kid.

JAX – Yeah, going there with our parents and making friends for life, hey buddy! *(Ruffles CHARLIE'S hair)*

CHARLIE – Get off you!

EZRA – It's going to be even better now we are all grown up.

LEIGH – I just hope it's exactly how I remember it.

SAM – Everything about it was amazing!

BO – *(In a dreamy way)* The food.

CHARLIE – The entertainment.

LEIGH – Oh. Look at this one of us all in the mini club!

(They ALL rush around to look)



ALL - Awwwwwwwwww.

JO – We all look like we were having the time of our lives.

BO – And talking of time guys... Our flight.

[Suggested song] SUMMER HOLIDAY – Cliff Richard
****The song you choose should have an innocence and holiday like feel****

(Throughout the song the friends end up at Sunshine Sands with a few miserable looking guests. They ALL look around confused and sad)

Scene 4 – Sunshine Sands Present Day

EZRA – This can't be right

JO – This isn't the same as I remember.

SAM – *(Hopeful)* Maybe it's because things look different from when you're young...

QUINN – 4 and 2, 42.

GUEST – *(Unenthusiastically)* Bingo.

MORGAN – *(Trying to gee up the small crowd)* Well done! Give our winner a big round of applause.

(There is a slow clap from those playing)

AUBREY – And here's your prize! *(Handing out a coconut)*

(The winning GUEST takes the coconut and is decidedly unimpressed)

PEYTON – *(Trying to appear upbeat)* Hello and welcome to Sunshine Sands.

PARKER – The happiest holiday destination there is.



AUBREY – Have you been here before?

BO – Ummm yeah, we used to come here every summer when we were younger but...

CHARLIE – But I think we have made a mistake.

LEIGH – Where are all the people?

JO – Where are all the games?

SAM – Where's the entertainment?

BLAKE – *(Down trodden)* Cut backs I'm afraid. No budget for shows and costumes. We do still get in the parrot show though!

EZRA – The parrot show... Uggggghhhh.

JAX – Not a fan?

EZRA – Not exactly, no. Once you've seen one you've seen them all!
Oh, look a parrot on a bike. Oh, look a parrot dinging a bell.
Oh, look a parrot sitting in a deck chair. Oh, look...

JAX – All right Ezra we get your point.

ROBIN – But surely you still do all the fun day time stuff right?

LEIGH – Aqua gym?

JO – Zumba?

FRANKIE – No, no money to train up instructors.

BLAKE – No money for equipment.

PEYTON – No money for...

PARKER – *(Interrupting)* No money for... anything really.



[Suggested song] MONEY, MONEY, MONEY – Abba

****The song you choose should be about wanting money and success****

SAM – I’m so sorry things have gotten so bad.

PARKER – Well, I don’t see how they could get any worse...

(INSPECTOR BARNES, SMITH and COOPER enter)

BARNES – Good afternoon.

SMITH – We are here from trip-assistor.com.

COOPER – We have heard some... not so good things about this
place (Looking at their clipboards) One review states that
it has ‘Gone downhill!’

ALL INSPECTORS – Hmmmm.

SMITH – ‘Ropey!’

ALL INSPECTORS – Hmmmmmm.

BARNES – ‘Doesn’t feel very Sunshiny at all!’

SMITH – We cannot possibly have you claiming to be a 5 star rated
hotel on our website when this sort of thing is happening.

COOPER – So...we are checking in. *(They click their fingers)*

(Bags are brought in by ALL STAFF who look very concerned)

BARNES – We will be guests in your hotel for a week so we can
really see how bad this place has become.

SMITH – We will be marking you on three things.

COOPER – Day time activities.



MORGAN – *(To AUBREY)* But we don't have any?

BARNES – Hospitality and restaurant.

HAYDEN – *(To LOGAN and MAX)* Quick hide the weird grey stuff.

SMITH – And of course your entertainment and mini club.

(MORGAN and AUBREY look at each other nervously)

COOPER – And if we deem that these three things are not to our satisfaction... We are shutting you down.

LOGAN – What! You can't do that!

SMITH – So, shall we begin by someone taking us to our rooms.

(The STAFF fall over themselves trying to fuss over them and take their bags. INSPECTORS and Staff exit)

PEYTON – *(With a feeling of doom)* That's it, it's over.

(PEYTON, PARKER, FRANKIE and BLAKE exit)

JAX – This can't be the end of this place? We have to do something.

ROBIN – Do something! I'm supposed to be on holiday.

CHARLIE – *(Thinking)* Right, all we have to do is make sure we go wherever the inspectors go...

BO – And if they see anything they don't like we jump in there and do something!

JO – Do what?

BO – I haven't figured that bit out yet... but it'll come to me.

SAM – Come on let's get to it! ...
