A VERY VILLAINOUS THERAPY SESSION

Synopsis

‘A Very Villainous Therapy Session’ is a fast-paced comedic ensemble piece set in a chaotic group therapy session where some of the most infamous villains have been sent to confront their behaviour. What begins as a structured attempt at rehabilitation quickly spirals into disorder, as oversized egos, rivalries, and denial take over.

The therapists struggle to maintain control while the villains interrupt, argue, and mock the process. As each character reluctantly introduces themselves, they reveal the “reasons” they’ve been sent to therapy, ranging from arrogance and jealousy to theft and attempted murder. However, rather than showing remorse, most villains justify their actions, twist the truth, or proudly embrace their misdeeds.

Clashes erupt and ultimately, we see these characters are far more comfortable remaining exactly who they are, delighting in their wickedness.

CHARACTER OVERVIEW

The Therapists

Two well-meaning professionals desperately trying to keep order as a room full of notorious villains refuses to cooperate.

The Villains

A collection of iconic fairytale and fantasy villains, each convinced they have done absolutely nothing wrong.

The Sidekicks

From loyal henchmen to chaotic followers, these characters provide plenty of comic interruptions and reactions throughout.

The Animal Villains

Scar, Shere Khan, Lotso and the Hyenas bring extra chaos, rivalry and larger-than-life personalities to the session.



SCRIPT SAMPLE

A VERY VILLAINOUS THERAPY SESSION

(A semi-circle of chairs are laid out. THERAPIST 1 is walking around, greeting people as they enter and take a seat. THERAPIST 2 is standing by the door, welcoming people. Throughout the scene EVIL QUEEN is subtly moving around the group offering her pie. All the characters at some point take some pie from her)

THERAPIST 1 – Hello everyone. Thank you so much for taking the time out of your busy day to come and...

CRUELLA – *(Storming in)* Enough!

THERAPIST 2 – Excuse me... Sorry... but it is against company policy to wear sunglasses inside.

CRUELLA – Is that so...?

THERAPIST 2 – Yes. So please if you don't mind.

JAFAR – *(Sauntering in)* This is beyond ridiculous. I have much better things to be doing with my time.

IAGO – Tell me about it. Jafar, why did you drag me along to this? I'm not evil.

JAFAR – Guilty by association my friend!

MALEFICENT – *(Walking over to a seat)* Is this seat taken?

THERAPIST 1 – Er... I think...

MALEFICENT – It is now.

EVIL QUEEN – *(Offering a tray around)* Would anybody like a slice of my delicious, home baked, apple pie?

CRUELLA – You must think I was born yesterday! I'll pass.



EVIL QUEEN – How about you?

GASTON – Not for me! It's not good for the diet. I need to look fit and undeniably handsome to try and win back Belle from that ugly beast! I will have an apple though.

THERAPIST 2 – I think that's everyone. Excuse me... Can I have your attention plea....

URSULA – *(Entering)* What kind of a place is this? Do you have ANY idea how hard it is to get here from the ocean...

CAPTAIN HOOK – As a matter of fact I do!

URSULA – Was I talking to you?

SMEE – Look tentacles pipe down.

URSULA – What did you call me?

SMEE – Hook... Help me!

EVIL QUEEN – Apple pie...?

CAPTAIN HOOK – Don't mind if I do.

SCAR – *(Entering)* Sorry I'm late. For some reason the lady on the front desk had an issue with letting me, a Lion into the building. No idea why? I'm potty trained!!

STEPSISTER 1 – *(Entering)* Stop pushing me!

STEPSISTER 2 – You pushed me first!

BOTH – MUM!!!!

STEPMOTHER – Girls... PLEASE!!! This is going to be intolerable if you carry on like this all day.

STEPSISTER 1 – I don't even know why we're here.



STEPSISTER 2 – That pathetic wimp of a girl Cinderella should be here not us!

STEPMOTHER – Well as part of our ‘sentence’ we have to go to talking therapy so it was either this or...

THERAPIST 1 – Excuse me... Please ladies take a seat.

QUEEN OF HEARTS – Hurry up! I’m missing a game of croquet for this... rubbish. So, the quicker you sit down and shut up the quicker we can get on with it! Do I make myself clear?

STEPSISTER 1 – Ok lady. Don’t get your knickers in a twist!

QUEEN OF HEARTS – Do you know who you’re talking to?

STEPSISTER 1 – No and I don’t care!

QUEEN OF HEARTS – *(Frantically)* I’m a QUEEN!!! Off with her head! OFF WITH HER HEAD!!

STEPSISTER 2 – Good try lady. See ya!

(The HYENAS enter)

HYENA 1 – Scar, you left us out in the car park!

HYENA 2 – There were cars everywhere!

HYENA 3 – We nearly DIED!!!

SHERE KHAN – *(Entering)* What is with all the noise? Oh, I could’ve guessed it would be you lot!

SCAR – Well look who it is?

SHERE KHAN – Hello Scar!

SCAR – There’s only room for one four legged villain in this group!

SHERE KHAN – Well I suggest you leave immediately then!



EVIL QUEEN – Is anyone else thinking the same thing as me...?

SMEE – What's that?

EVIL QUEEN – Well there's your lion, there's your tiger, now all we need is...

GASTON – Dorothy...?

URSULA – No you oversized, pumped up buffoon!

LOTSO – *(Entering)* Did someone order a Bear! Move over you lot. The baddest bear in toy world is here! What's crack-a-lacking? Did I miss anything good?

(All Villains talk amongst themselves)

THERAPIST 2 – Please could I have your attention... Ladies and Gentlemen... If I could have your attention this way...

MALEFICENT – ENOUGH!!! *(All look shocked and stop talking)*

THERAPIST 2 – Er... Thank you. Right, everyone. It's so good to see so many lov... *(Quickly rethinks what they were about to say)* to see so many faces here today.

CRUELLA – Get on with it! I've tied my dog up outside and don't want anyone to steal her. She's worth a lot!

THERAPIST 1 – Ok. Well as you're aware you are all here for the same reason. The first step to being a better person and living a more fulfilling and wonderful life is admitting your faults. So, one at a time I'd like you to stand up and tell the rest of the group your issue! Please!!!

(Each taking it in turns to stand up when it's their go)
